#### Making Payments/Fundraising:

Costa Rica Soccer Tours will accept payments via their service that accepts Credit Cards or bank account transfers. We could establish a raffle or other fundraisers over the summer.

## **Refund Policy:**

All payments for the land portion of the trip are refundable up to 60 Days before departure (Nov 10). Thereafter, refunds of the land portion trip payment (\$2000) are not guaranteed. Airline cancellations after Nov 10 will result in future credit with that airline unless a replacement traveler is found. Each traveler can purchase trip cancellation insurance to cover their trip costs.

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### 1. Do I need a passport to go to Costa Rica?

Yes, a valid passport is mandatory to enter Costa Rica.

# 2. Do I need a visa to go to Costa Rica?

No, U.S., Canadian, and many European citizens may enter Costa Rica without a visa.

#### 3. Is the water drinkable in Costa Rica?

Yes, you will be able to drink from the tap at all of the places to which we will be traveling on our tour.

#### 4. Is Costa Rica safe?

Costa Rica is a very safe, stable democratic country.

## 5. What is the currency in Costa Rica?

The Costa Rican currency is called Colon. US dollars and major credit cards are widely accepted.

## 6. Can we buy travel medical insurance?

Yes. Check if your medical coverage extends to Costa Rica for the trip. Otherwise, supplemental travel medical coverage can be purchased in advance.

#### 7. How much cash should I plan to bring?

The amount of cash you need to bring depends on the snacks and souvenirs that you want to buy. In general, around \$200 to \$300 is good.

# 8. Do I need any special vaccinations?

No vaccinations are presently required to enter Costa Rica. You are unlikely to encounter any serious diseases in Costa Rica. Sanitary standards are high and the health system is excellent.

#### 9. How much is the airport departure tax?

A departure tax of \$26 is required at the airport but is included with your airfare.

#### 10. What is the Cancellation and Refund Policy?

#### Airfare Cancellation and Refund Policy

Cancellations processed by Nov 10 are partly refundable. A portion of your air deposit could be lost or could be refunded as an airfare credit with the selected airline. However, a portion of your flight may be refundable if you change the person traveling for a fee.

#### **Land Portion Cancellation and Refund Policy**

Payments processed before Nov 10 are fully refundable. Cancellations after Nov 10 will result in a loss of the land portion program fee of \$2000. If for some reason the trip is canceled, we would attempt to reschedule in March for Spring Break 2026.

\*\*We highly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance and each traveler should confirm their health insurance coverage while in Costa Rica.

# 11. Are there optional/additional sightseeing activities and how much do they cost?

Yes! We need at least 10 people to do some of the sample activities listed below at the Beach. If there are some people who don't want to participate in the group activity they have down time at the hotel to relax, shop, etc.

**Hot Water Springs:** Enjoy the beauty of soaking and swimming in mineral hot springs, waterfalls, 12 mineral pools and indoor Jacuzzi, surrounded by tropical gardens.
